- All teachers new to the Division of Adult and Career Education start on step A.
- A teacher must work 734 hours in one year in order to advance to the next step. (Plus 30 hours of staff development)
- Step increases become effective on July 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
- To be eligible for step 4, a teacher must work 734 hours in each of ten consecutive years.

## SUBSTITUTES

- Teachers employed in the Division of Adult and Career Education prior to July 1, 2001, who substitute will be paid on Step 1 (Flat Rate).
- Teachers employed in the Division of Adult and Career Education on/or after July 1, 2001, who substitute will be paid on Step A (Flat Rate).
